

## Standard Size Pillowcase With No Raw Edge Seam Allowances

### Supplies:

3/4 yard fabric for body

1/3 yard coordinating fabric for band

### Instructions:

1. Cut body of the pillowcase 26 1/2" x 40 1/2"
2. Cut band of pillowcase 10 1/2" x 40 1/2"
3. Open and press both cut pieces.
4. Layer the pieces in the following order, with **RIGHT SIDES FACING UP**. Band fabric on the bottom then top with body fabric matching raw edges at the top.
5. Grab the bottom edge of the body fabric, turn it up and roll loosely upward, exposing the wrong side of body fabric. Continue rolling until it exposes about half of the band fabric underneath. Now bring the bottom raw edge of the band fabric up and over the rolled body fabric and place right side down aligning all the raw edges along the top. ( This will resemble a "tube") Pin securely. Sew through all three layers with 1/4" seam allowance.
6. After sewing, reach inside the "tube" and turn the piece right side out. Press the band. Fold the pillowcase wrong sides together trimming any loose threads and pin the side and bottom. Sew together with 1/4" seam.
7. Turn the pillowcase inside out (the right side of fabric will now be on the inside). Press. Sew down side and bottom with a 3/8" seam.
8. Turn right side out and press.
