



MARTHA'S SUPER SIMPLE NAME TAG

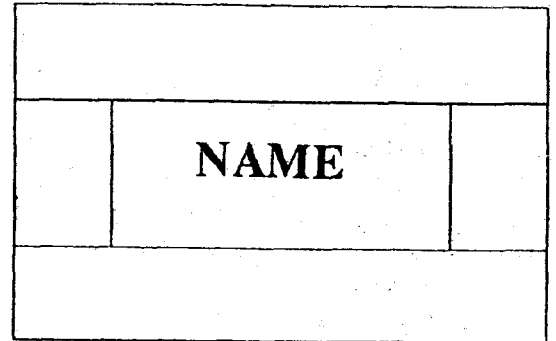
This name tag is easy to put together so you can have it ready to wear at our next meeting.

MATERIALS

- Cut 1 White or light colored fabric for center: 3" x 3 1/2"
- Cut 2 Side borders in contrast fabric 1 3/4" x 3"
- Cut 2 Top and bottom borders in contrast fabric 1 3/4" x 6"
- Cut 1 Back in contrast fabric 5 1/2" x 6"
- Cut 1 Batting or fleece 5 1/2" x 6"

All seam allowances are 1/4"

1. Sew borders to 3" edges of center fabric.
2. Sew top and bottom borders to long edges of name tag.
3. Write your name in the center.
4. Layer front and back, right sides together.
5. Lay batting on wrong side of back. Pin.
6. Stitch through all three layers in 1/4" seam. Leave an opening to turn.
7. Trim excess batting at corners. Turn right side out. Slip stitch opening closed.
8. Machine stitch in the ditch around the center area.



To wear your name tag, pin on with a straight pin.
