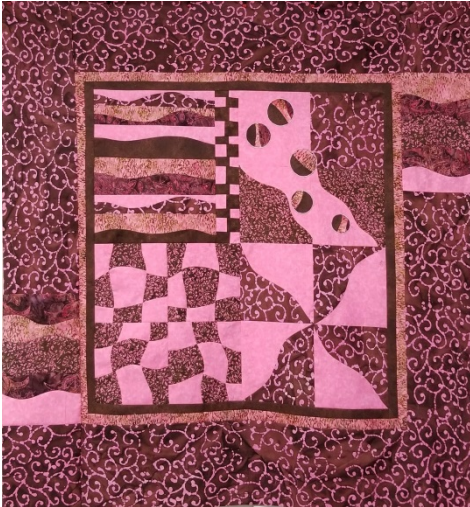

Curvy Improv is a pattern that brings together my love of free-form curved piecing techniques and raw edge applique. My liberating approach takes all the traditional rules for perfect cutting and piecing and tosses them right out the window making this a fun and worry-free project for quilters of all levels.

Once you know the basics of how to create these blocks you will see the endless possibilities of creation! One of the best things about this quilt pattern is I show how to make use of the last of the scraps on the back of the quilt so there is very little waste. It goes together fast and fun and can be completed in a couple of days. Class limited to 20 students

Cost: \$50 includes cost of pattern

SUPPLY LIST

Select two contrasting colors - 3 or 4 fabrics of each light and dark fabric will be sufficient
12 – 10.5 inch squares (6 light/6 dark)

20 strips between 3 and 5 inches wide by 20-24 inches long in a variety of your light/dark colors

1/4 yard dark for inside border number one

1/4 yard dark for inside border number two

1-1/4 yards dark for outside border (one and one-quarter yards)

Heat & Bond Lite or other fusible web (must be sewable)

2 yards batting of your choice

65 x 65 backing fabric (approximate)

1/4 yard binding
