Description:

License to Play: A twist on tradition as we explore creative ways to modify some of our favorite traditional block patterns. We will also play with several new techniques and embellishments as we build our own small wall hanging size "License to Play".

CAUTION -ever "License" will be completely different and unique based on the items you bring!

Supply list:

- Sewing Machine
- Basic sewing and sewing machine supplies, including an open toe foot for zigzag
- 4-5 Orphan or leftover blocks - optional
- 2 -3 fat quarters or equivalent fabric. Can be any type fabric. Doesn't need to be cotton.
- Scraps of fabric to coordinate
- Thread that both matches and contrasts
- Fun Stuff - Scrap pieces of trim, ribbon, buttons, zippers, old costume jewelry
 - Does not need to match – we will swap/trade
- 12x12 batting and backing fabric
- Colored pencils, crayons, or markers
- Paper cutting scissors

- Table space for student sewing machines and sufficient electrical outlets
